The below is a status update on the Coachella Valley Water District's official registered positions on bills within the state legislature and Congress.

<u>State</u>

AB 334 (Rubio): Public contracts: conflicts of interest. CVWD position: Support

Status: AB 334 passed Senate Elections and Constitutional Amendments Committee, and was rereferred to the Senate Judiciary Committee with a hearing scheduled July 6th.

AB 460 (Bauer-Kahan): State Water Resources Control Board: water rights and usage: interim relief: procedures.

CVWD position: Oppose via ACWA coalition

Status: AB 460 is assigned to the Senate Natural Resources and Water Committee; it was scheduled to be heard on June 27th but was not. It is awaiting a new hearing date.

AB 557 (Hart): Open meetings: local agencies: teleconferences. CVWD position: Support

Status: AB 557 was assigned to the Senate Judiciary committee.

AB 755 (Papan): Water: public entity: cost-of-service analysis. CVWD position: Oppose

Status: AB 755 was assigned to the Senate Natural Resources and Water committee with a hearing scheduled July 10th.

AB 1337 (Wicks): State Water Resources Control Board: water diversion curtailment. CVWD position: Oppose via ACWA coalition

Status: AB 1337 was assigned to the Senate Natural Resources and Water committee with a hearing scheduled July 10th.

SB 23 (Caballero) Water supply and flood risk reduction projects: expedited permitting. CVWD position: Support

Status: SB 23 was held in the Senate Appropriations Committee making it a two-year bill. This means that it will need to pass out of Appropriations by January 31, 2024. This permit streamlining effort, however, is being addressed as an initiative by the Administration with a trailer bill.

SB 57 (Gonzalez) Utilities: disconnection of residential service.

CVWD position: Oppose

Status: SB 57 was re-referred to the Senate Energy, Utilities and Communications Committee. It did not pass out of policy committee and has in effect has become a two-year bill that would need to pass out of committee by January 31, 2024.



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SB 366 (Caballero) The California Water Plan: long-term supply targets. CVWD position: Support

Status: SB 366 was assigned to the Assembly Water, Parks, and Wildlife Committee and will be heard on July 11th at 9 am.

SB 389 (Allen) State Water Resources Control Board: determination of water right. CVWD position: Oppose via ACWA Coalition

Status: SB 389 was assigned to the Assembly Water, Parks, and Wildlife Committee and will be heard on July 11th at 9 am.

SB 583 (Padilla): Salton Sea Conservancy. CVWD position: Oppose

Status: SB 583 passed the Assembly Natural Resources Committee and is heading to the Assembly Appropriations Committee.

SB 687 (Eggman): Water Quality Control Plan: Delta Conveyance Project. CVWD position: Oppose via State Water Contractors Association

Status: SB 687 was held in the Senate Appropriations Committee making it a two-year bill, meaning it would need to pass out of committee by January 31, 2024.

<u>Federal</u>

H.R. 2964 (McClain): Wastewater Infrastructure Pollution Prevention and Environmental Safety Act (WIPPES Act)

CVWD Position: Support

Status: H.R. 2964 was recently introduced and assigned to the House Committee on Energy and Commerce.
